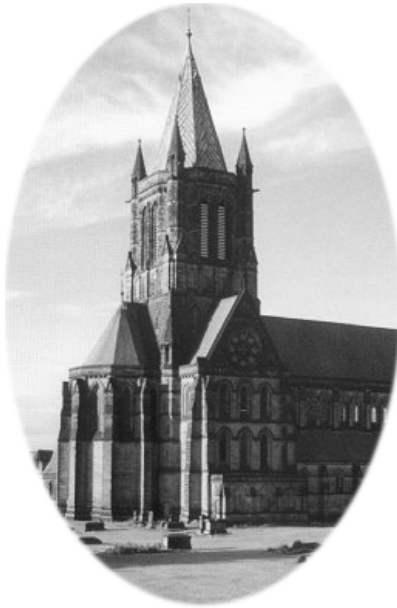


Installations - Places of Worship

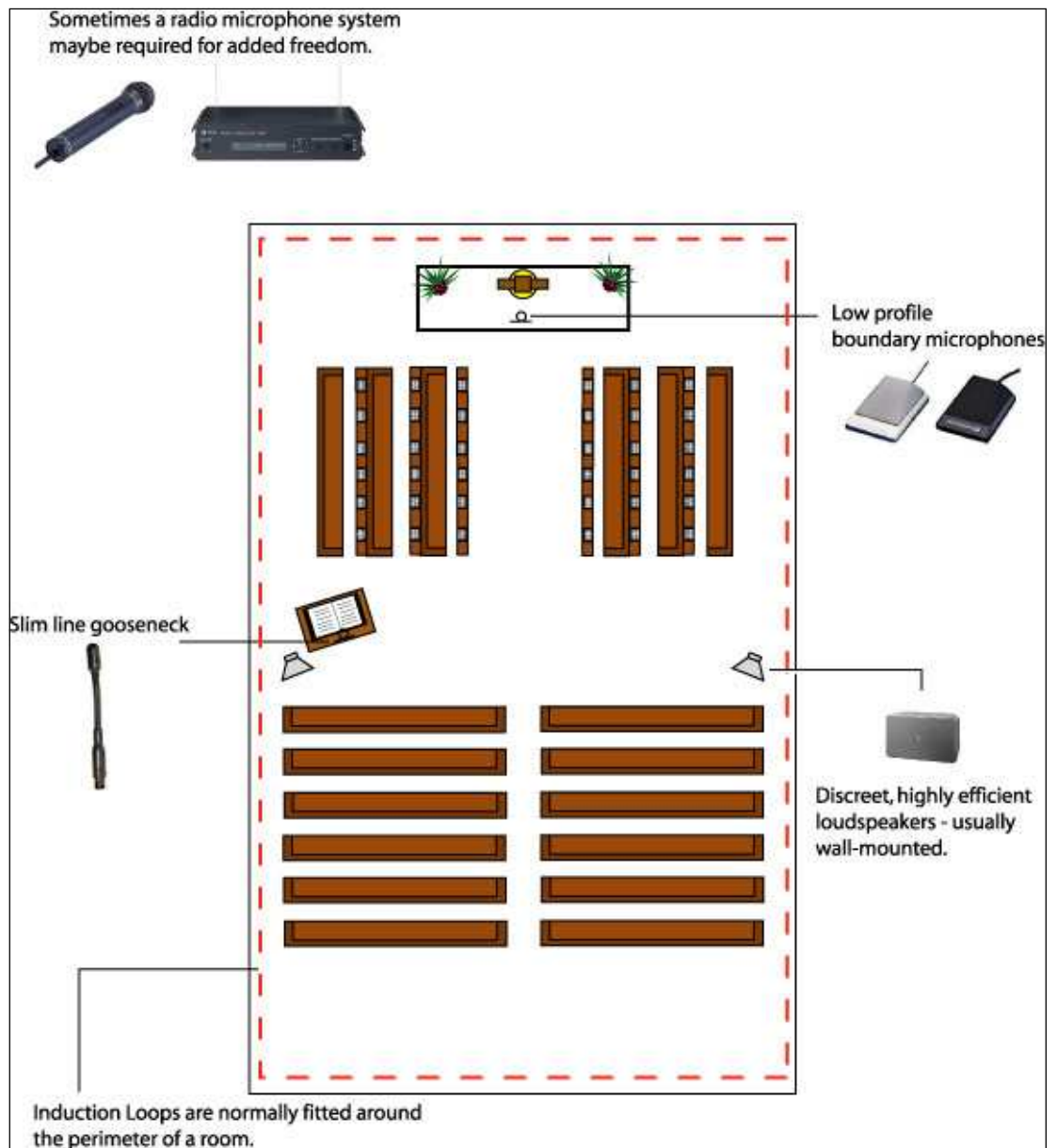
